How does an erection occur?

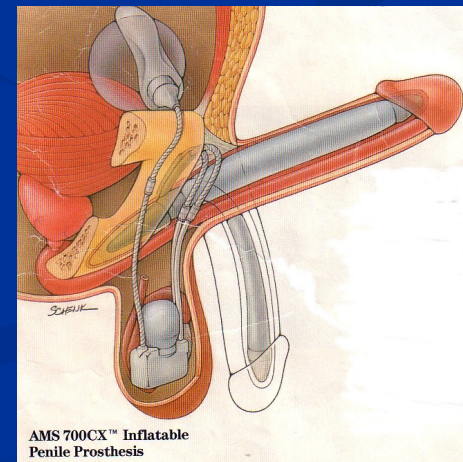
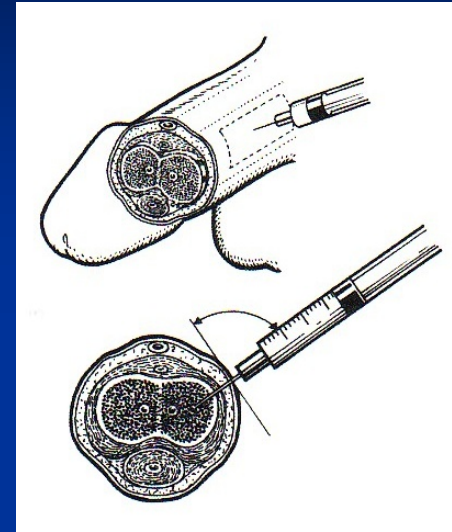
- The brain responds to stimulating thoughts or sensations by sending nerve signals to start the process.
- This causes the release of Nitric Oxide which dilates blood vessels and relaxes smooth muscle. Veins become compressed restricting blood flow out of the penis.
- The extra blood increases pressure within the penis, causing it to become hard and expand.

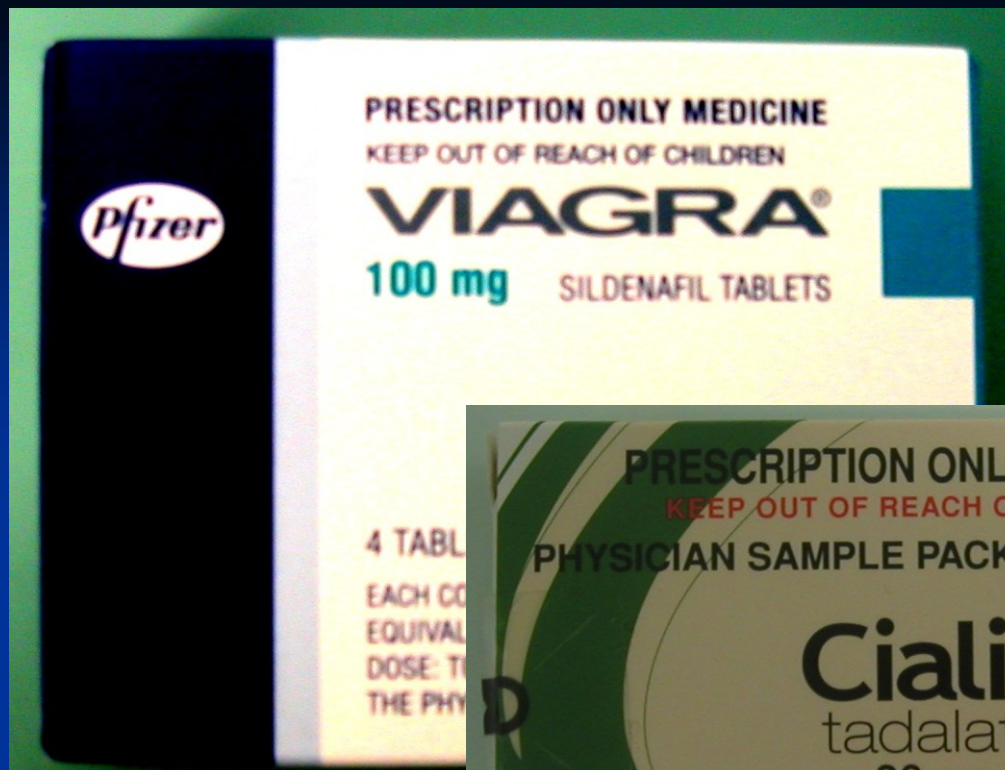

PDE5's

In order for a PDE5 to work effectively the following must occur:

- Appropriate dosage and time of taking the medication eg: with or without food, alcohol
- Erotic or stimulating thoughts – set the mood
- Manual stimulation and foreplay
- At least 6 attempts with the medication before making a decision
