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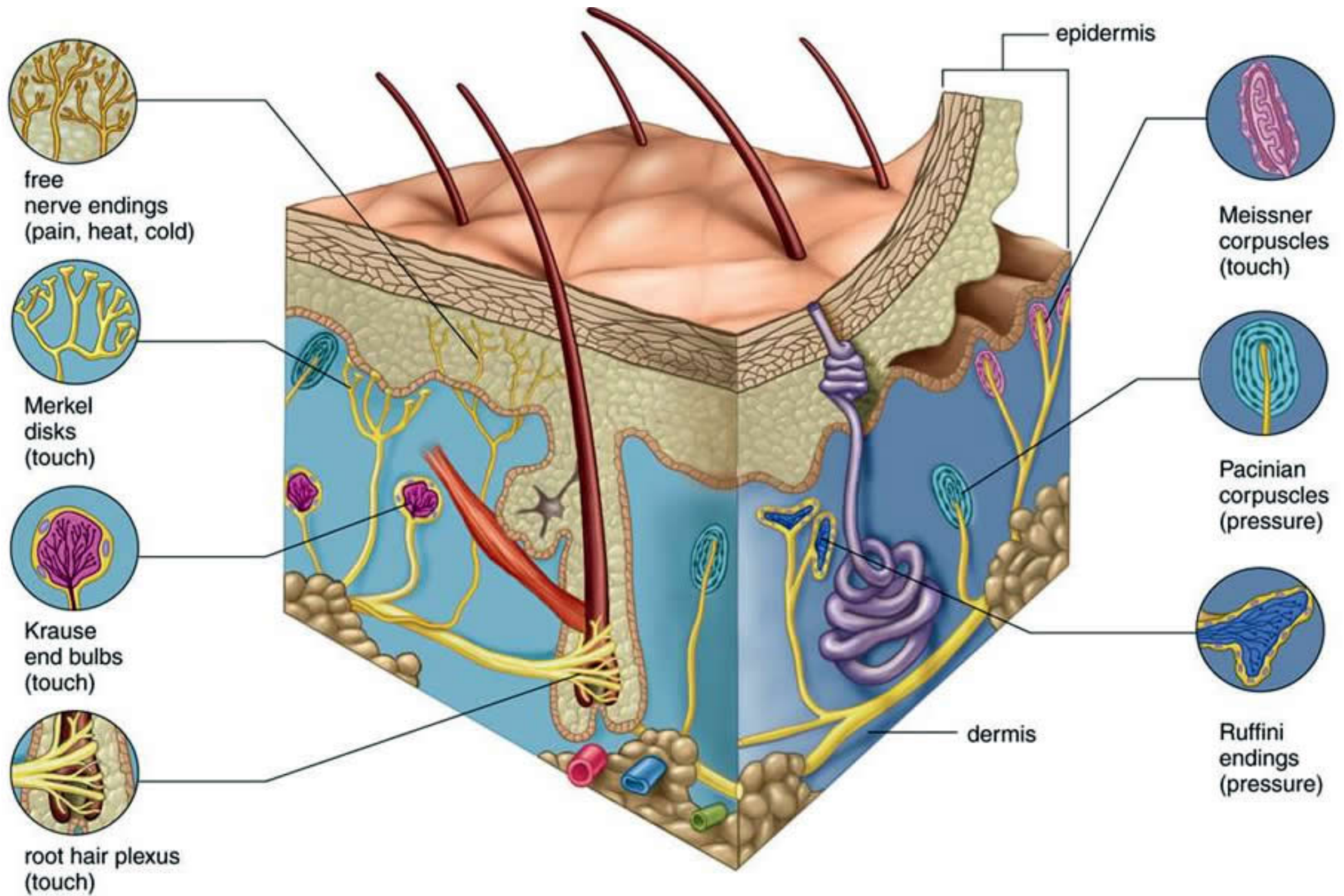


local anaesthetic

pain endings in **EPIDERMIS**

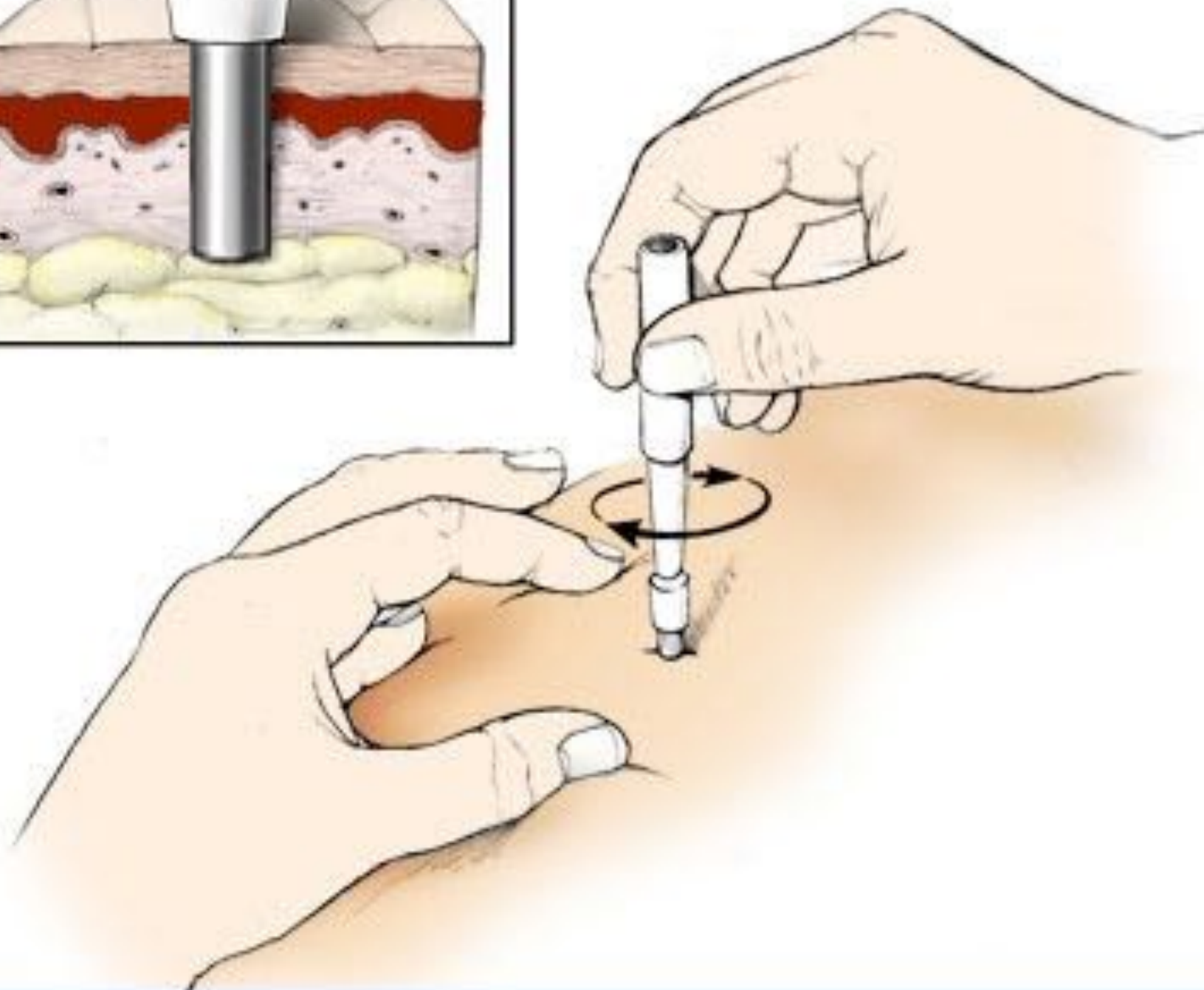
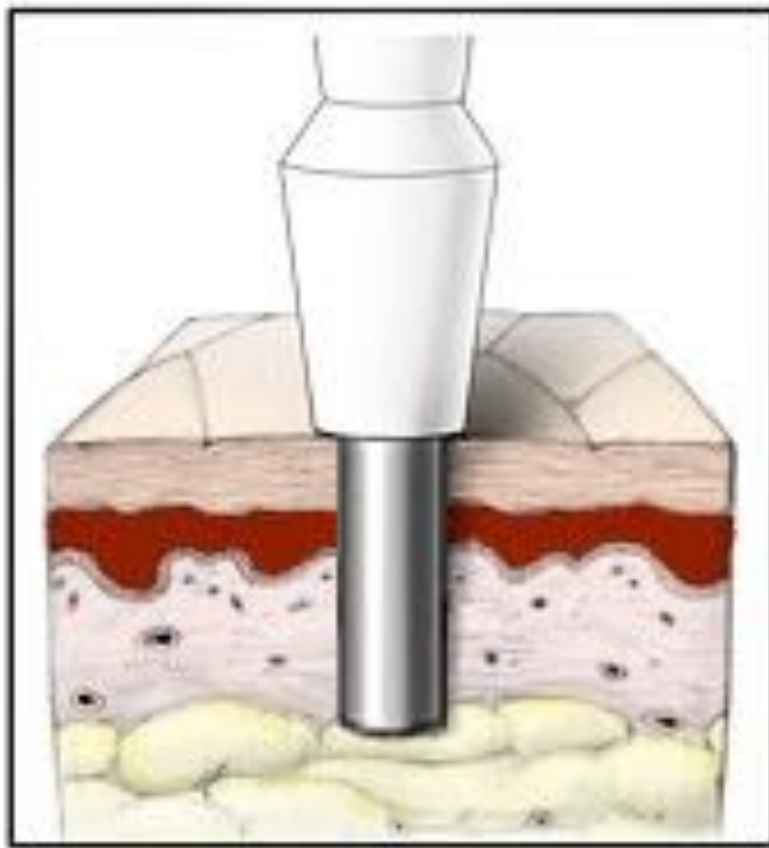
need very small amount of local

SKIN





shave biopsy

- suitable for larger pigmented lesions that won't fit into a punch biopsy







curettage

- suitable for larger pigmented lesions that wont fit into a punch biopsy
