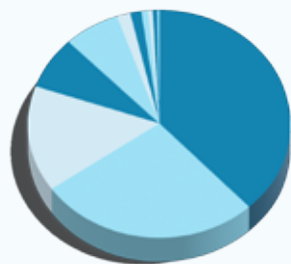
Attendee breakdown

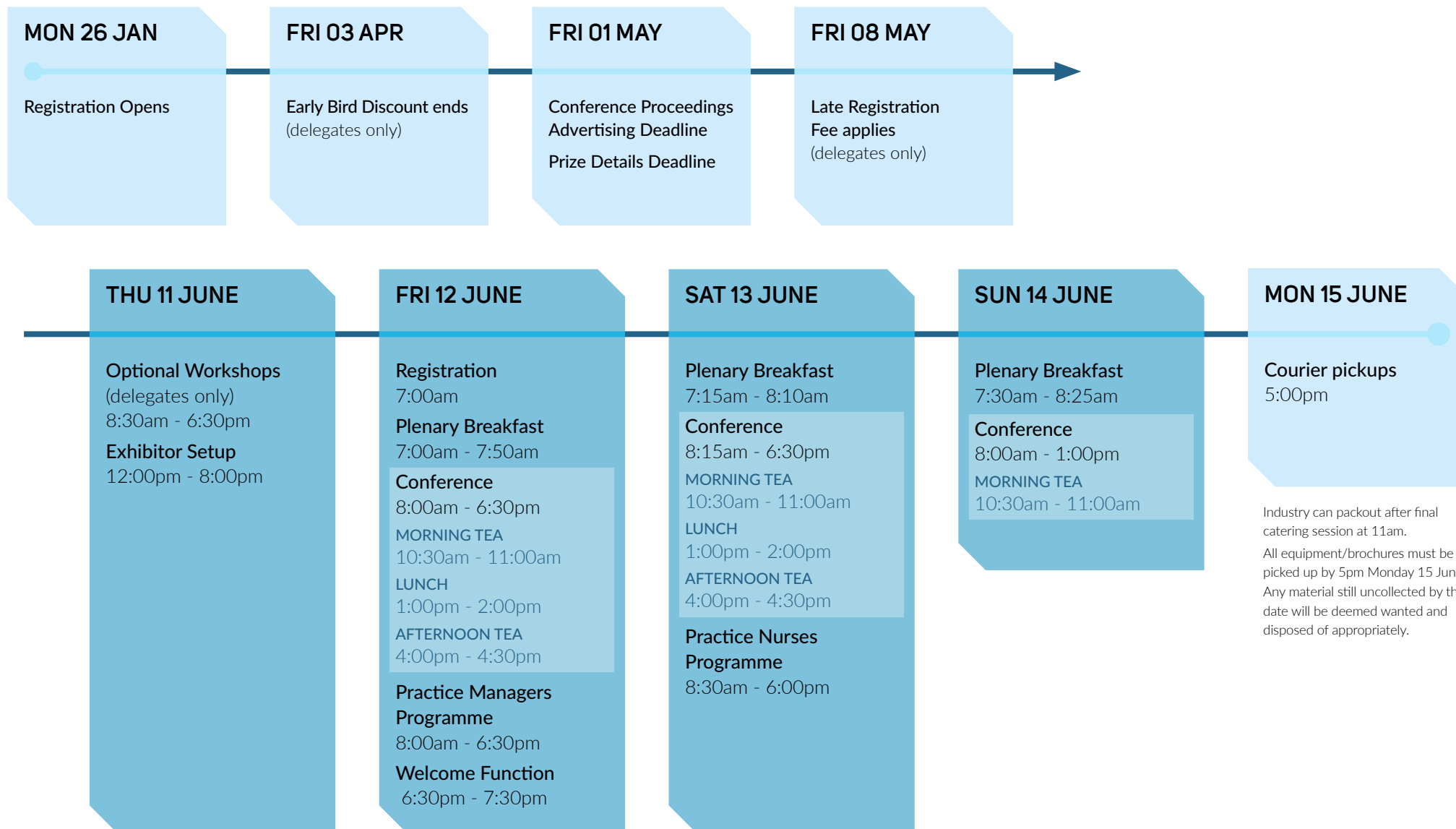

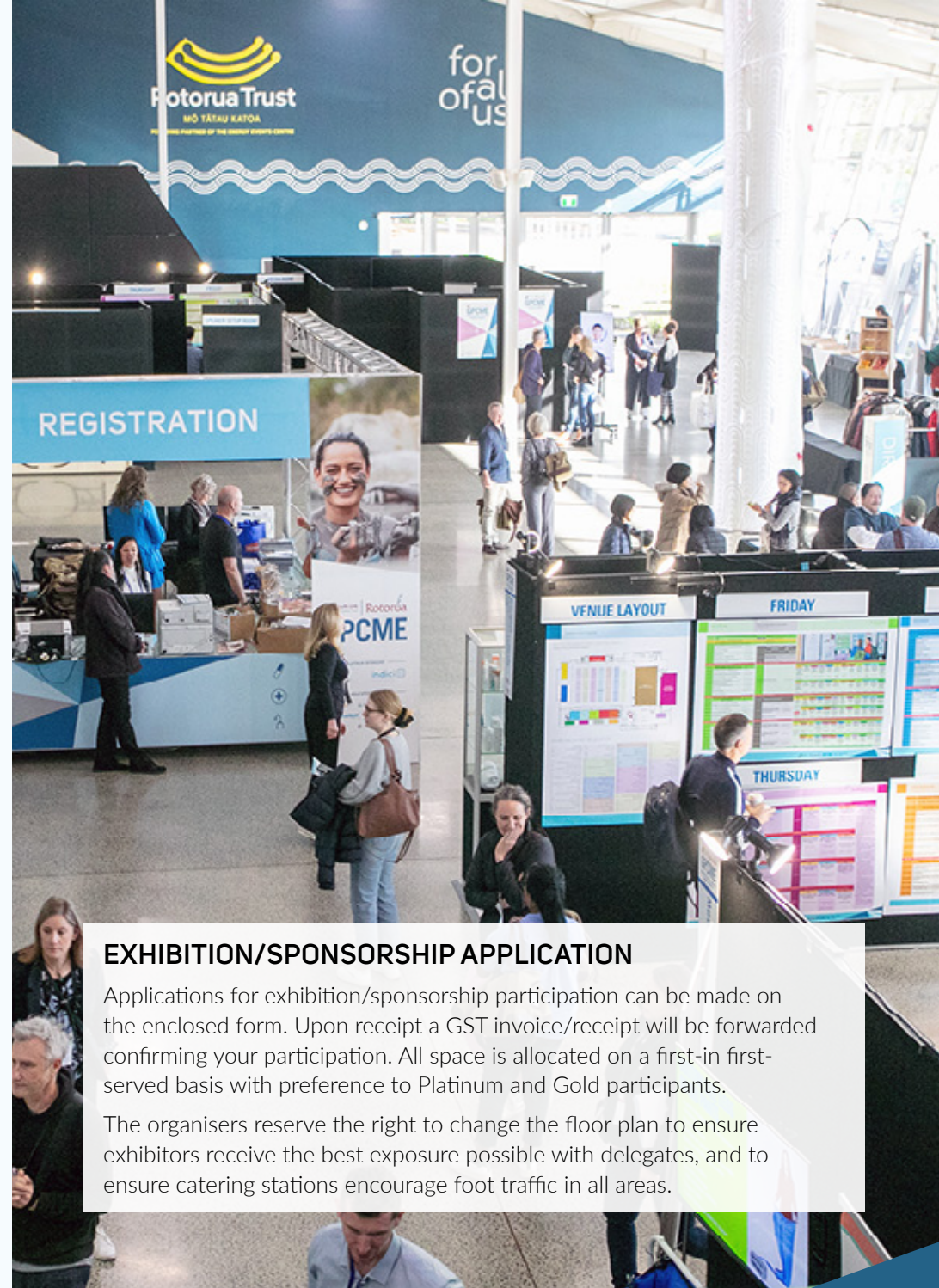

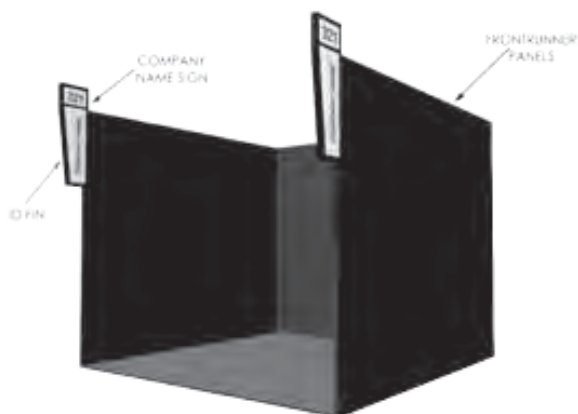

Custom Stand Design Guidelines

To maintain a visually balanced exhibition arena and ensure every exhibitor has a fair and equitable presence, the following stand design rules must be adhered to:

1. Standard Wall Heights

The standard wall height is 2.3m. This applies to all stand walls unless an exemption is granted under the conditions below.

2. Increased Wall Heights on Footprint Edge

Walls up to a maximum height of 3.5m are permitted on the footprint edge, provided they are no wider than 3.0m. These taller elements should be positioned to avoid obstructing sightlines or overshadowing neighbouring stands.

3. Taller or Wider Walls

Any wall or structure that is higher than 3.5m or wider than 3.0m must be set back at least 1.0m from the stand's perimeter (footprint edge). This setback helps preserve open sightlines and ensures no single stand dominates the visual field.

4. Hanging Banners and Overhead Elements

The bottom of any hanging banner must be positioned at least 1.0m above the highest solid wall or structure within the stand. For example, if your tallest wall is 3.5m, the lowest part of your banner must be no lower than 4.5m above ground level.

5. General Considerations

Stand designs should respect neighbouring exhibitors and maintain openness and visibility. Avoid blocking primary walkways or entrances to adjacent stands.

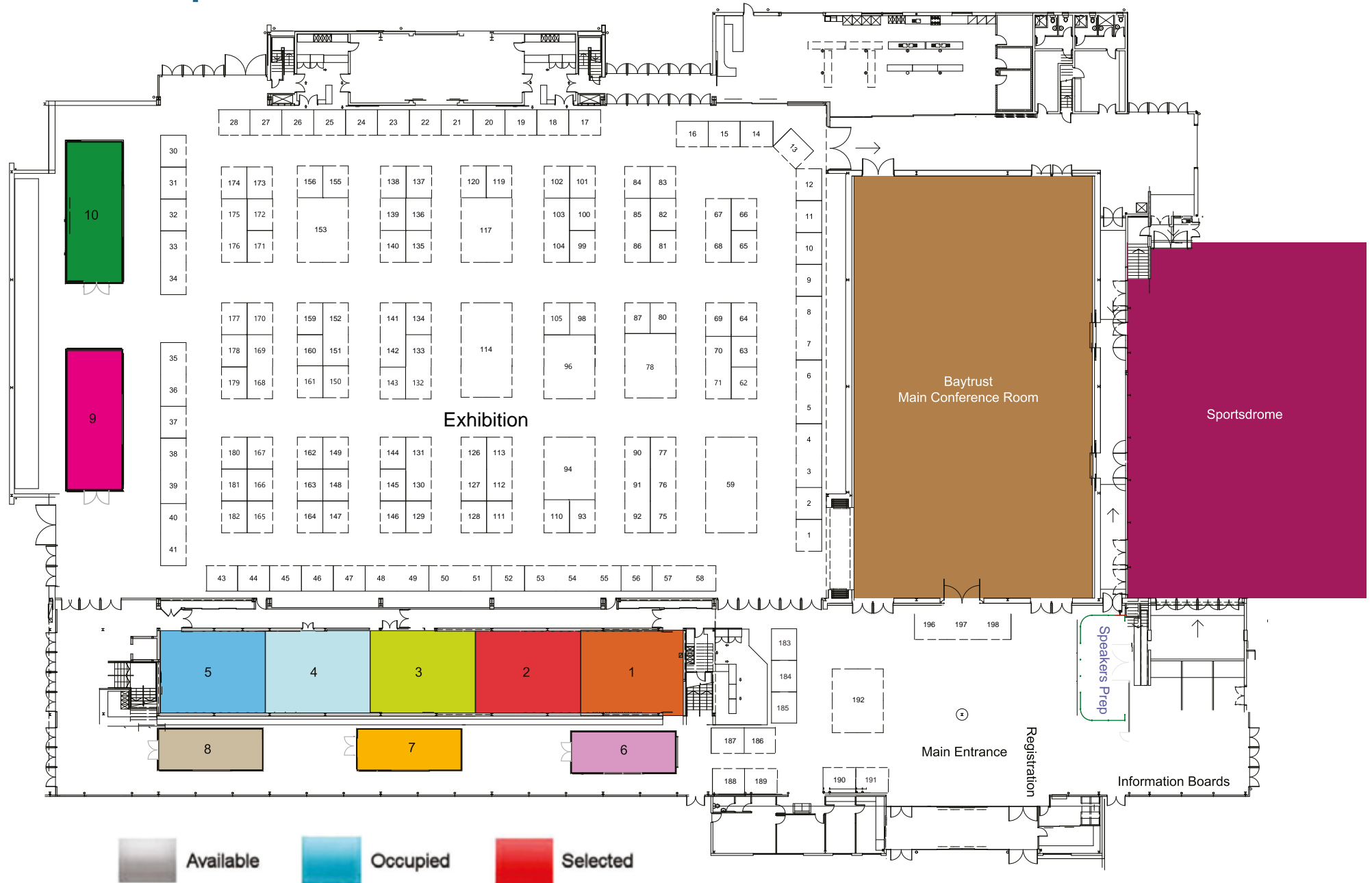
